

A. Luke 22:31-34 Peter's Denial Foretold

B. Luke 22:35-38 Forewarning of the Disciple's Use of the Sword

- a. 1. Luke 22:35 And he said to them,
"When I sent you out with no moneybag or knapsack or sandals, did you lack anything?" They said, "Nothing."
36 He said to them, "But now let the one who has a moneybag take it, and likewise a knapsack.
And let the one who has **no sword** sell his cloak and buy one.
2. 37 For I tell you that this Scripture must be **fulfilled in me**: 'And he was numbered with the transgressors.'
2' For **what is about me is having its fulfillment.**"
1' And they said, "Look, Lord, here are **two swords.**" And he said to them, "It is enough."
- b. Luke 22:39 And **he came out and went, as was his custom, to the Mount of Olives, and the disciples followed him.**
- c. Luke 22:40 And when he came to the place, he said to them, "**Pray that you may not enter into testing.**"

C. Luke 22:39-41 Jesus' Prayer

- a. Luke 22:41 And **he withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed,**
b. Luke 22:42a saying, "Father, **if you are willing**, remove this cup from me.

C' Luke 22:42b-45 Jesus' Prayer

- b' Luke 22:42b Nevertheless, **not my will, but yours, be done.**" *Textual Variant: Omission results in a more balanced/concise chiasmic structure*
Omit 43 And there appeared to him an angel from heaven, strengthening him.
Omit 44 And being in agony he prayed more earnestly; and his sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.
- a' Luke 22:45 And when **he rose from prayer, he came to the disciples** and found them sleeping for sorrow,

B' Luke 22:46-53 The Disciple's Use of the Sword

- c' Luke 22:46 and he said to them, "Why are you sleeping? Rise and **pray that you may not enter into testing.**"
- b' Luke 22:47-48 While he was still speaking, **there came a crowd, and the man called Judas, one of the twelve, was leading them.**
He drew near to Jesus to kiss him, 48 but Jesus said to him, "Judas, would you betray the Son of Man with a kiss?"
- a' 1. Luke 22:49-53 And when those who were around him saw what would follow, they said, "Lord, shall we strike with the **sword**?"
2. 50 And one of them struck the servant of the high priest and **cut off his right ear.**
2' 51 But Jesus said, "No more of this!" And he **touched his ear and healed him.**
1' 52 Then Jesus said to the chief priests and officers of the temple and elders, who had come out against him,
"Have you come out as against a robber, with **swords** and clubs?
53 When I was with you day after day in the temple, you did not lay hands on me.
But this is your hour, and the power of darkness."

A' Luke 22:54-62 Peter's Denial
