- 1/1. The Outward/Bodily Experience of Suffering > to HOPE
 - a. Expressed (*Present*)
 - b. Explained Hardships > (Patient) Endurance
 - Endurance > (Tested) Character
 - Character > Hope
 - 2/2. The Subjective Basis of our Hope: God's LOVE via Spirit
(By the figure of speech) we are presently boasting in hope because inwardly (mind) we know God's love for us through the indwelling Holy Spirit given to us. (Past)
 - 1/2' The Objective Basis of our Hope: God's LOVE via Christ
 - a. We were still Weak (*Past*)
when Christ died for the ungodly
 - b. Dying for a Righteous Person
 - b' Dying for a Good Person
 - a' (*Present*) Demonstration of God's love:
We were still Sinners
when Christ died for us
 - 2/1' The Inward/Mind Reasoning of Faith > HOPE
 - a. Premise Expressed – Put into right standing (Now)
by his sacrificial death
 - b. Conclusion Expressed - We will be saved from wrath
 - b' Premise Explained - Greater/Harder Deed
 1. Foes

 3. By his Death
 - a' Conclusion Explained - Lesser/Easier Deed
 - 1' Friends
 - 2' Saved
 - 3' By his Life
- A' Our Relationship with God (Based on Love)
- a. Resulting Relationship: We Boast "in God"

 - a' Resulting Relationship: (Now) Received Reconciliation

Rom. 5:1
Therefore, since we were put into right standing from faith,
we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Rom. 5:2
Through whom indeed, we have obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand,
and we are boasting upon hope of the glory of God.

Rom. 5:3
Yet not only that, but also we are boasting in the afflictions since we know that the affliction produces *for itself* endurance,

Rom. 5:4
and endurance produces proof,
and proof produces hope.

Rom. 5:5
Now hope does not put us to shame,
because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

Rom. 5:6
For while we were still weak,
at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

Rom. 5:7
For scarcely on behalf of a upright *person* will anyone die - for on behalf of a good person one might even dare to die -

Rom. 5:8
but God is demonstrating his own love for us because while we were still sinners,
Christ died for us.

Rom. 5:9
Much more then, since we were put into right standing now by his blood,
we will be saved by him from the wrath.

Rom. 5:10
For if, while we were enemies,
we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son,

how much more, since we were reconciled,
will we be saved by his life?

Rom. 5:11
Yet not only that, but we also boast in God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
through whom now we have received reconciliation.
