and bore daughters

Sons of God saw daughters of humans were beautiful  
And took wives from among them

D' **120-year Limit to Humans**

**C' Exacerbation - Sons of God / Daughters of Men**

- a. Giants on the land then (and afterward)
- b. Whenever Sons of God had sex with daughters of humans
- b' They produced offspring
- a' Giants

**B' Multiplication of Human Wickedness**

- 1. Cause - *Wicked deeds of humanity multiplied*  
*Every thought of humanity was evil*
  - 2. Effect -
    - a. God considered He made Humankind (on the land)
    - b. God Reconsidered
- x **God's Disfavor**: God decided to wipe out humankind  
which he made (= everything "on" wiped "from" face of land)
- b' Because God was extremely angry
  - a' Because God made humankind

A' **Noah's Favor** – Found favor with God

Gen. 5:32 (6.0)

And Noah was five hundred years of age,  
and Noah became the father of three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Gen. 6:1

And it came about when humans began to become numerous on the land,  
that daughters also were born to them.

Gen. 6:2

Now when the sons of God saw the daughters of humans, that they were fair,  
they took wives for themselves of all that they chose.

Gen. 6:3

And the Lord God said, "My spirit shall not abide in these humans forever,  
because they are flesh,  
but their days shall be one hundred twenty years."

Gen. 6:4

Now the giants were on the land in those days and afterward.  
Whenever the sons of God used to go in to the daughters of humans,  
they produced offspring for themselves.  
Those were the giants from the past, the men of renown.

Gen. 6:5

Now when the Lord God saw that the wicked deeds of humans were multiplied on the land  
and that every intent of the thoughts within his heart was only evil continually,

Gen. 6:6

then God considered that he had made humankind on the land,  
and he reconsidered.

Gen. 6:7

And God said, "I will wipe out humanity which I have made from the face of the land,  
from human to domestic animal and from creeping things to birds of the sky,  
because I am enraged  
because I made them."

Gen. 6:8

Now Noah found favor before the Lord God.
